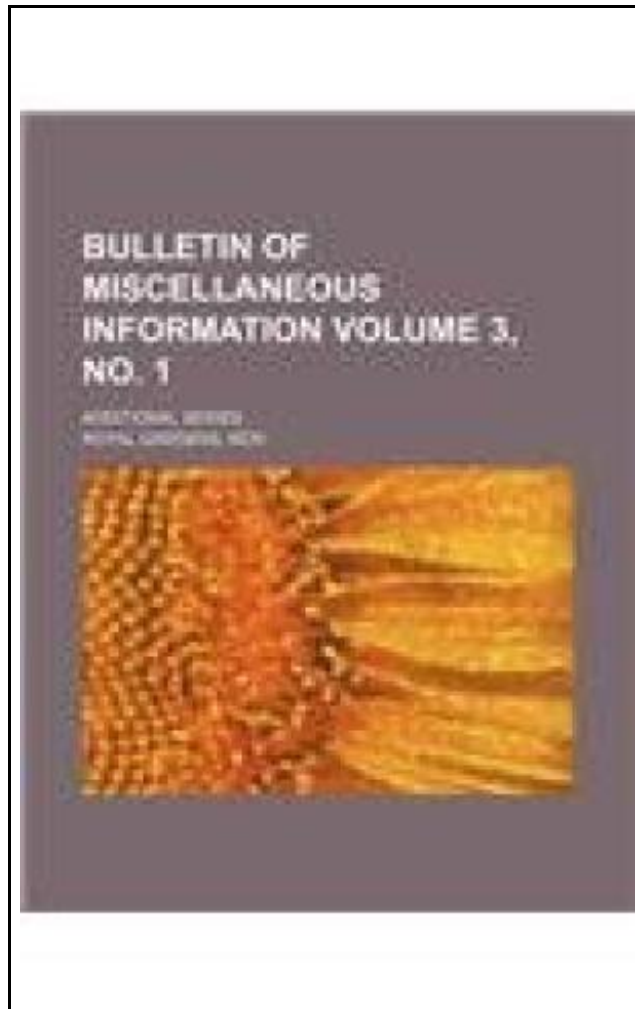

Not illustrated. 1898 Excerpt: . . . hoped that efforts will be made to teach agriculture, at least theoretically, in the elementary schools, and to start school gardens, so that the cultivation and treatment of the soil may become more popular than they appear to be at present amongst the rising generation. In regard to the latter point the Committee charged with the preparation of evidence for the Royal Commission states that the advanced educational programme has greatly crippled the labour supply, and deprived agriculturists of the services of the younger portion of the labouring class. This is understood to refer to the continuation of children at school beyond a certain age. The same subject is discussed in the statement submitted by the various ministers of religion as follows: -- In many instances the acquisition of a small holding results in the persistent labour of the individual owner, while the younger generation, knowing that their parents possess as much as to furnish necessaries, are content to grow up in anything but a thrifty condition. In this respect small holdings do not tend to promote thrift, especially among the younger generation. We are of the opinion that the lack of thrift, and the indifference of the younger generation, might be remedied by the introduction of the subject of agriculture in the school curriculum. The theory of agriculture may be taught by the use of textbooks, or as one of the subjects in the higher standards of the elementary schools; but the present staff of teachers...
